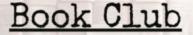

Because of its prevalence and serious consequences, hoarding is now considered a diagnosis independent of formerly associated disorders such as obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD). Currently popularized by several "Reality TV" shows, hoarders find it difficult or impossible to discard or part with possessions, regardless of their actual value. Offering case examples, discussion will include strategies for treatment and intervention for those affected by this disorder, as well as those seeking to assist others.

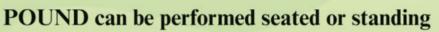

City of Bridgeport

Chartered as a city in 1836, Bridgeport was originally occupied by the Pequonnock Indians of the Paugussett nation. A community of fishing and farming, Bridgeport's coastal location led it to become a center for shipbuilding and whaling. The addition of ready access by train transportation in the mid -19th Century spurred the development of this well positioned city to become famous as a regional center of engineering and manufacturing during the 20th Century.

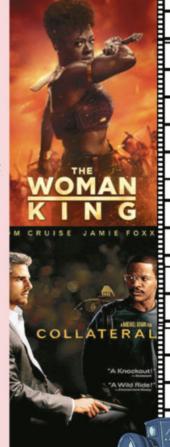

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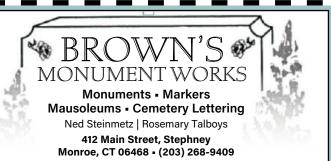
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
