Coney Island: A Special Presentation by Art Gottlieb



Steeped in Brooklyn folklore, Coney Island is a traditional New York attraction famous for it's Boardwalk, arcades and sea-side attractions. The area boasts of three landmarks

that are listed on the National Register of Historic Places: the Wonder Wheel Ferris Wheel built in 1918, the Cyclone roller coaster, and the Parachute Jump, the latter two transplanted from the 1939 World's Fair.

Andrea Doria

The pride of the post-war Italian Line, the Andrea Doria collided with the Swedish Line's Stockholm in dense fog off Nantucket in the summer of 1956. Despite being designed in a modern age with both ships carrying radar and the latest safety features, human error still led to the death of 54 passengers and the complete loss of the Andrea Doria.

Self-Fulfilling Prophecy Art Gottlieb, LCSW, CSA Friday May 24th at 1:30pm

This program will discuss the tendency for people to unconsciously shape events toward certain preordained outcomes. The essential factor is that people's actual motivations are oftentimes in direct conflict with their consciously stated goals and behavior. It is the goal of the psychotherapist to uncover the hidden motivating behaviors, often protected by layers of a person's defense mechanisms, to bring understanding as to why, despite people's best efforts, the outcomes always seem to be pre-ordained failures.


