
With the cooler weather, unless needed, please refrain from using the automatic door openers. In the vestibule you will notice our new umbrella bag holder, bags are available and free for your convenience

"On this day of remembrance, let us pray...that there will be no veterans of any further war - not because all shall have perished but because all shall have learned to live together in peace"








Canasta is a partnership card game in the rummy family where teams aim to be the first to reach a target score
