WHAT TO BRING:

PCB capacitors Car wax Airplane glue Metal powders **Polishes** Fiberglass resin Organic powders Driveway sealer Photo chemicals Paint (oil-based & latex) Roofing tar Chemistry sets Stains & varnishes Swimming pool chemicals Furniture polish Wood preservatives **Poisons** Floor & metal polish

Paint strippers/thinners Insecticides Oven cleaner

Solvent adhesives Drain & toilet cleaner **Fungicides**

Lighter fluid Chemical fertilizers Spot remover

Fuels/gasoline/kerosene Weed killers Rug & upholstery cleaner

Engine degreaser Moth balls **Hobby** supplies Brake fluid/carburetor cleaner Flea control products Artist supplies

Transmission fluid Rubber cement Fluorescent light bulbs

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

Compressed Gas Cylinders/Propane

Asbestos **Tires** Antifreeze Ammunition, Fireworks, Explosives Radio actives, Smoke Detectors Waste Motor Oil Infectious & Biological Wastes Car Batteries

Prescription Drugs/Syringes **Household Alkaline Batteries**

Commercial or Industrial Waste Cooking Oil

Empty Containers

HOW TO SAFELY TRANSPORT THESE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS:

Bring materials in original containers – securely closed.

Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper, if necessary.

Never mix chemicals together.

Never smoke or eat while handling hazardous materials.

Leaking or broken containers must be contained.

Do not leave vehicles unless instructed to do so.
