2023 MEMORIAL DAY PARADE LINE OF MARCH

DIRECTIONS FOR ALL PARADE PARTICIPANTS

In order to get to the line-up point on Lower Elm Street heading towards Monroe Turnpike (Route 111), ALL participants MUST assemble by traveling one of the following routes:

Purdy Hill Road (East, Post Office Side) turn left onto Lower Elm Street toward Monroe Turnpike

Moose Hill Road (South) turn right onto Lower Elm Street toward Monroe Turnpike

Cross Hill Road (East) turn right onto Moose Hill Road and then right onto Lower Elm Street toward Monroe

Turnpike

Unless you are walking YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER from Route 111/Lower Elm Street after 12:15 p.m. You'll need to drive through the 'back end' of Lower Elm Street and come up Lower Elm towards Route 111.

Marchers will assemble at their assigned number(s) on the right-hand side of Lower Elm Street ONLY. The left side of Lower Elm Street MUST remain open for vehicles/floats to travel in order to find their assigned spots. Please look for a parade committee member if you have not received your assigned number ahead of time or if you need assistance. We will have identification and are happy to assist you.
