

**TOWN OF MONROE  
BOND FOR HIGHWAY MODIFICATION PERMIT**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That \_\_\_\_\_ Inc.  
as principal, and \_\_\_\_\_

held and firmly bound jointly and severally unto the Town of Monroe, Connecticut, in the sum of  
\_\_\_\_\_ Dollars to be paid to the Town of Monroe for which well and truly to be made we  
hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns firmly by these  
presents.

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH THAT WHEREAS the Principal has made  
application to the Town of Monroe for a permit to make openings and excavations in the public streets,  
highways, sidewalks and alleys within the Town of Monroe under permits therefore which may be issued  
from time to time by said Town and whereas said Town is prepared to issue such permit to the Principal  
pursuant to the ordinance adopted by the Monroe town Council, April 15th, 1969 and

Whereas said ordinance provides that qualified excavators and utility companies may, in lieu of a  
cash deposit for each permit applied for, file with the Town of Monroe an annual bond in the amount of  
\_\_\_\_\_ Dollars;

Now therefore, if the said \_\_\_\_\_ shall well and truly  
keep and perform all the terms and conditions the aforesaid ordinance as the same may be amended  
from time to time, any conditions set forth in the application filed pursuant thereto, and any conditions  
attaching to any permit issued pursuant to said ordinance and shall forever indemnify and save harmless  
the Town of Monroe and all it's respective agents for or on account of any damages to property or to any  
person or persons, or any damage to any utilities furnished in the Town of Monroe in consequence of or  
resulting from any work performed by said principal \_\_\_\_\_ servants or agents, or  
of, or from any negligence in guarding said work, or of, or from any act or omission of said principal  
\_\_\_\_\_ servants or agents until the expiration of the maintenance period; shall  
faithfully perform said work in all respects and shall also replace and restore that portion of any street in  
which said applicant, his servants or agents shall make any excavation, to the Town standards currently  
applicable to new construction, and shall also keep and maintain such street in like good condition to the  
satisfaction of the Town's Agent for the period of not less than one year after completing said work, and,  
should the Town's Agent or other official, within said period and after notice to said principal repair said  
portion of such street, the principal shall pay the cost thereof within thirty (30) days, and shall comply in  
all respects with the rules and regulations established by the Town's Agent relative to such work, and the  
terms of the permits that may be issued to him, and shall also pay all fines or penalties imposed upon him  
for violation of any such rule or regulations, then this bond shall be void but otherwise shall remain in full  
force and effect.
